I. DISCUSSION ITEMS

I1. Annual Report to Council Update

Chair Stallworth, Vice-Chair Carson, and Commissioner Christian attended the annual report to the City Council, where they highlighted the commission's many successful programs. The audience expressed appreciation and actively engaged by asking questions.

I2. Moreno Valley State of the District Update

Commissioner Torres shared highlights from his attendance at the State of the District meeting, noting how much he enjoyed the performances. He expressed interest in positioning the library as a venue that offers engaging experiences and ideas for pre-college students.

13. Symposium with McGraw Hill Textbook Publishing Company

Commissioner Hilliard, who also serves as Chair of the Science Department at West Coast University, attended the event and provided an update on ADA requirements, textbooks, and other resources, noting how they may be beneficial.

14. Increase Cultural History

Commissioner Diaz presented two proposals: a brief survey and an oral history project designed to capture local historical accounts, preserve community memories of those who came before, and incorporate an educational component.

15. 40th Celebration Time Capsule

To commemorate Main Library's 40th Anniversary, Commissioner Carson proposed a "40 for 40" initiative: selecting 40 items to be placed in a time capsule to be sealed for 40 years, with the contents and surrounding display highlighting library programming and local history. Commissioners recommend establishing a subcommittee to fulfill the obligations of this celebration and decide the sub tasks.

16. Little Free Libraries Update

Commissioners provided status updates on each LFL, including visiting and maintenance of their respective LFL.

17. Library Conferences and Upcoming Training Opportunities

Serving With a Purpose will take place on Thursday, May 14, 2026, at Ontario Convention Center. Registration opens February 1, 2026.

18. Commissioner Proposals

Commissioners shared ideas and provided updates on proposals to establish productive strategies to increase community engagement while providing resourceful information relating to library services.
