NOTICE OF UNSCHEDULED VACANCY

An unscheduled vacancy exists on the:

LIBRARY COMMISSION

Pursuant to Section 54974 of the California Government Code, notice is hereby given that a vacancy exists on the City of Moreno Valley Library Commission as of February 10, 2026. The unexpired term will end June 30, 2026.

Applicants must be residents of the City of Moreno Valley. No person previously convicted of a felony in this state or elsewhere shall be permitted to serve on any City commission. Before assuming the duties of a commissioner, each person appointed shall take and file with the City Clerk the same constitutional oath of office required of members of the City Council. Any member of a commission shall be deemed to have resigned from the commission, and his or her office as a member of the commission shall automatically be vacated, in the event the member ceases to be a resident of the City or is convicted of a felony.

Advisory Board and Commission applications may be obtained at the City Clerk's Office: 14177 Frederick Street, Moreno Valley, Ca. 92552. Applications will be accepted in the City Clerk's Office on a continuous basis until an appointment is made. Please call the City Clerk's Office at (951) 413-3001 for more information.

Appointment to the Library Commission shall not be made by the City Council for at least ten (10) working days after the posting of this notice in the office of the City Clerk. Therefore, appointments can be made after March 12, 2026.

California Government Code § 54974

- a) Whenever an unscheduled vacancy occurs in any board, commission, or committee for which the legislative body has the appointing power, whether due to resignation, death, termination, or other causes, a special vacancy notice shall be posted in the office of the clerk of the local agency, on either the local agency's Internet Web site or at the library designated pursuant to Section 54973, and in other places as directed by the legislative body, not earlier than 20 days before or not later than 20 days after the vacancy occurs. Final appointment to the board, commission, or committee shall not be made by the legislative body for at least 10 working days after the posting of the notice in the clerk's office.
- b) Notwithstanding subdivision (a), the legislative body may, if it finds that an emergency exists, fill the unscheduled vacancy immediately. A person appointed to fill the vacancy shall serve only on an acting basis until the final appointment is made pursuant to this section.
