## RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING GUIDELINES



### PAPER

Copy paper, mail, envelopes, inserts, paper bags, newspapers, magazines, brochures, wrapping paper, phone books, paperback books.



### PLASTIC

Clean plastic cups, assorted food and drink bottles, milk jugs, plastic laundry jugs, shampoo bottles, lotion bottles.



### CARDBOARD

Clean paper cups, cereal boxes, tissue boxes, gift boxes, paper bags, milk & juice cartons, frozen food boxes.



### GLASS

Assorted drink bottles, salad dressing bottles, condiment jars, jam & jelly jars, baby food jars, assorted food jars.



### ALUMINUM,

Aluminum drink cans, fruit & vegetable cans, soup & sauce cans, pet food cans, pie tins. Please rinse & empty cans.

## The Following Items Are Not Accepted

### ELECTRONIC AND HAZARDOUS WASTE

Fluorescent tubes and bulbs, electronics (PCs, cellphones, tablets, TVs, etc.), batteries, sharps, unused medication, aerosol cans, paint, used oil, pesticides, cleaners, and cooking oil, are hazardous products that **DO NOT** go in the recycling or garbage container.

### NON-ACCEPTED GLASS

Ceramics dishes, drinking glasses, broken glass.

### NON-ACCEPTED PLASTIC

Plastic bags or film (reuse or recycle at grocery store), plastic plates or utensils, styrofoam containers or packaging.

### OTHER NON-ACCEPTED ITEMS

Clothing or shoes, rugs, diapers, hoses, light bulbs, windows, mirrors, needles, syringes, toxic containers (paint, oil, antifreeze, pesticides, etc.).
